Tournament Rules and details available upon request...standard poker rules will apply to all tournaments. Payouts will adhere to the Illinois charitable games act. Players must be 18 years of age and a legal U.S. resident to participate in the tournament. The tournament director has the final determination in any aspect of the game which includes player conduct, participation, and or removal from a tournament. The hosting charity will keep between 20-30% of the entry for their fundraising and required state taxes. The remaining balance will be put into the prize pool. No more than 15% of the prize pool will be used for promotions including high hand promotions, bounties, or last longer promotions. The charity reserves the right to award donated promotional prizes as part of the tournament in the form of high hand promotions, bounties, or even as part of the final prizes. The tournament dates, structures, and details are subject to change pending state approval and or verification. Pre paid entries into any tournament are non refundable but are transferable. Players who finish in the money, or receive a promotional prize must present proper state or government I.D. to collect winnings and or prizes. No outside food or drink allowed. Players must be present to pay for their buy-in or to enter any event, or transfer a seat entry to another participant. All players must sign in and fill out an entry form which includes your name, address, phone number, email address, and tournament or cash buy in. Any tournament entry is non-refundable. The entry is however transferable to another player. Both the owner and new player must be present to transfer funds.

All structures, payouts, and tournament details are subject to change at anytime. Tournament rules are available upon request.

Players may use their cell phones or tablets during a hand for listening to music or watching video. Players may text while at the table as long as they are not involved in a hand. Any player texting or talking on their cell phone will not be allowed to play their hand. Players must step away from the table in order to make or receive a phone call. Players may text at the table as long as they are not involved in a hand.
